## **Robbery Suspects Located and Arrested**

Kettering- Alexander J. Rill and Matthew L. Jackson, both twenty-one year old Kettering residents were arrested on June 6 for Aggravated Robbery.

The two suspects reportedly entered Meijer at 4075 Wilmington Pike at approximately 7:40 p.m. and stole meat, miscellaneous food and two air horns. The loss prevention officers from Meijer identified themselves and attempted to detain the subjects. Rill fought with the loss prevention officers and then said he had a knife. Jackson and Rill then split apart and ran in different directions.

Kettering officers flooded the area and located Jackson on Roslyn Avenue. A witness advised officers that Jackson had thrown objects into bushes. The stolen merchandise was recovered. Rill was located by officers in a wooded area on E. Stroop Road at Hempstead Station. A folding knife was found in Rill's pocket. Stolen merchandise and a hooded sweatshirt were also recovered.

Rill and Jackson were arrested for Aggravated Robbery and booked into the Kettering Jail. The case will be presented to the Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office for formal charges.
