POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, January 4, 2010

1749 Officers McGuire and Drayton responded to 3424 N. Marshall for a disturbance. During their investigation, they learned the occupant of apartment 303 was wanted on a nationwide warrant from Baldwin County, Alabama. Confirmation was received via teletype as well as telephone, and Judith I. Holloway, w/f/46, was placed under arrest. She was transported to KPD and then later the MCSO jail. 2010-523

Wednesday, January 6, 2010

1638 Officer Soto responded to Kroger on E. Dorothy for a female shoplifter in custody. The investigation revealed that the suspect concealed \$81.09 in merchandise and then passed all points of sale without paying for the merchandise. Heidi R. Jones, w/f/29, was placed under arrest and transported to KPD jail without incident. (10-857)

1703 Officer Hawley responded to Meijer for a female shoplifter in custody. The investigation revealed that Ashley Matheson, w/f/26, had picked up a prescription from the pharmacy and then left the store without paying. Further investigation revealed that Matheson had a prescription and pill bottles in her purse with different names on them. Officer Hawley then contacted Det. Kowalski who assisted in the investigation. Matheson was eventually transported to KPD jail and charged with Felony Theft and Deception to Obtain a Dangerous Drug. Matheson was also wanted on three warrants through MCSO. In the jail, Matheson did admit that the names on the script and prescription bottles were false. (10-853)

Thursday, January 7, 2010

0249 Off. D. Warren and L. Warren were dispatched to the 900 block of Willowdale Dr. on the report of a truck striking a tree. The caller advised that the subjects were walking eastbound on Willowdale Dr. away from the accident scene. Off. D. Warren arrived on scene and found the driver of the vehicle in the 1000 block on foot. The subject stated he was looking for his female passenger who was on foot and injured. The female was found at 1012 Willowdale Dr. She had an injury to her head and medics were called. The male was found to be under the influence of alcohol. He was arrested and transported to the Kettering Jail. Lloyd A. Winegarner (W/M/22) was charged with OVI, his bac showed to be .141. He was also charged with possession of a controlled substance.

1935 Officers Savino and A. Pedro were dispatched to the area of Stroop and Overland on the report of a vehicle stopped in the roadway which was possibly involved in a hit and run. Officers arrived on scene and found the vehicle stopped in the middle of Stroop Road blocking both east bound lanes. The vehicle had fresh front end damage.
