Monday, January 18, 2010

1925 Officers responded to 2217 E. Dorothy Lane for a possible family trouble. At the scene, Officer Aldrich learned one of the occupants was wanted on a warrant through Fairborn Court. The warrant was confirmed and Eddie L. Wallace, w/m/29, was placed under arrest and transported to KPD. (10-2811)
