Monday, February 1, 2010

1714 Ptl. Stout stopped a vehicle in the area of Shroyer and Dorothy after recognizing the driver and determining he was DUS. Patrick W. Wooten, W/M/43 was arrested for Driving Under OVI Suspension and a warrant through MCSO. 10-5281
