Wednesday, February 10, 2010

1850 Ptl. Soto stopped a vehicle for several moving violations in the lot of 1421 E. Dorothy Ln. During the course of the stop, he requested the assistance of Ptl. Price and K-9 "Bandit" for a free air sniff of the vehicle. K-9 Bandit alerted on the vehicle indicating that drugs were inside. Ptl.
