Monday, February 15, 2010

At approximately midnight, Officers Disalvo and Lambert were at Kettering Hospital on another call when they were approached by hospital staff and asked if they were there in relation to the subject who had fallen from the motor home. Investigation revealed an intoxicated male subject had indeed fallen from the moving vehicle suffering minor injuries. The employee/driver of the motor home (a "party bus" rented by the group of people) was re-contacted and agreed to respond to KPD. Once at KPD, the driver admitted to lying about the incident at the time of the stop partly because he did not want to get in trouble. Craig A. Byrd, w/m/38, was issued a misdemeanor citation for Obstructing Official Business. (10-08356)
