POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, March 1, 2010

Ptl Geisel was dispatched to the Butler County Jail on a warrant service. Upon arrival, he arrested Christopher Bevins on an active Kettering warrant. He was transported to KPD jail without incident.

1547 Ptl. Soto was dispatched to Patterson and Woodman on a Signal 10 with a possible OVI driver. While interviewing Unit #1, Soto could detect a strong odor of alcoholic beverage on her breath. When he requested that the driver conduct some field sobriety test, she refused. Arrested was Brenda K. Spencer W/F/51 for OVI. Spencer also refused all test at the jail as well. 10-9635

1627 Ptl. Pedro observed a passenger of a vehicle litter by throwing a cup onto the roadway in the area of Wilmington and David. She then stopped the vehicle and upon running the occupants for a routine warrant check, an active warrant was found for one of the passengers. Arrested was Matthew A. The suspect was contacted and said he was at Kroger and claimed he told the employee "this is how you wind up with a bullet in your head." At the completion of the investigation, Bernard L.
