POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, March 8, 2010

1530 Officer Drayton and Sgt. Green responded to the area of Lisbon and Beaverridge on the report of a German Shepherd running at large. The officers located the owner of the dog at 1636 Beaverridge and also learned she was wanted on an active warrant through the MCSO. Further investigation revealed that her husband (also present) was also wanted on an MCSO warrant. The warrants were confirmed and James Stansell, w/m/29, and Amber Turner, w/f/27, were both placed under arrest and transported to KPD jail. 10-10793
