## **POLICE BLOTTER**

Tuesday, March 16, 2010

0247 Off. M. Woolf was northbound on Smithville Rd. when he observed a vehicle make a turn onto Tabor Av. without signaling. The operator continued to drive erratically and the officer initiated a stop in front of 2057 Lakewood Dr. There were three subjects in the vehicle. The driver was determined to be under the influence of alcohol and asked to perform the SFST's. MARY E. RAFFIELD, W/F/22 was placed under arrest for OVI. Raffield tested .150 on the Datamaster. KALEE RAE ZUKOWITZ, W/F/20, a passenger in the vehicle was arrested for Disorderly Conduct and transported to the Kettering Jail. 2010-12105
