POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, March 29, 2010

Officers were dispatched to the CVS on Woodman at Patterson for a possible theft. Upon arrival, they met with the suspect Adrian Barnes, and discovered he was responsible for theft of merchandise. He was arrested and transported to KPD jail.
