Monday, April 12, 2010

2101 Several officers responded to 2901 County Line Apt. E on the report of a male assaulting and dragging a female into the apartment. After a preliminary investigation and talking to several witnesses, officers concluded that Gregory L. Parsons, w/m/45 had assaulted his wife. He was placed under arrest and transported to KPD jail. His wife, Karla K. Parksons, w/f/40, was issued a summons due to her behavior at the scene and the fact that she was intoxicated. 10-16976

Tuesday, April 13, 2010

0003 An officer made a traffic stop on W. Stroop and Trails End. She suspected the driver of being OVI and after conducting a FST she arrested the driver, Scott J. Hunter (W/M/29) for OVI. He later refused to take a breath test.

0209 Officers were dispatched to 2056 Ashmore on a disturbance. Upon their arrival, they arrested Andrew M. Salyers (W/M/31) for Criminal Trespassing. Salyers had been trespassed from the property earlier by Officer Stout.

The male was barely able to give the officers enough information to identify himself. Officers were unable to make contact with family. 0502 An officer observed a male stagger across Wilmington Pk. and into the lot of the Wendy's at 4003 Wilmington Pk.. She made contact with this subject who was highly intoxicated. He stated he was at a party and was on his way home to Jamestown, Oh. ADAM M. SANDOVAL, W/M/20 was arrested for Public Intoxication and transported to the Kettering Jail. 2010-17737
