## **POLICE BLOTTER**

Monday, April 13, 2009

0106 Hours Crews were sent to Rich's Market, 2701 Wilmington Pike on the report of a B & E alarm at the store. Upon arrival the crews found the main business was still secure but a padlock to a gated area had been pried off and removed, the phone lines had been cut, and the security cameras had been repositioned. Officers cleared the alarm call and Off. Marcum then got out on bike in the area. He positioned himself in the bushes near the field at the dead end of Bobbie Place where a short time later three subjects came from behind the apartments on Bobbie through the bushes. Off. Marcum confronted the three individuals and called for other crews to assist. Several more crews responded and took Kevin J. Ashley, w/m/36, Kyle F. Nelson, w/m/22, and Audric D. Clay, b/m/22 into custody for Possession of Criminal Tools. Detectives Walker and Drerup were called in to interview the three as Ashley is the suspect in numerous recent B & E's, auto accessory thefts, and auto thefts. (09-17610 & 09-17618)

1830 Ptl. Steffano made phone contact with a subject he knew had a warrant and set up a meet at the Meijers. Sherri Rajchel arrived and was arrested on a warrant through Butler County.

2035 Ptl. Gaudette located a vehicle which was reported to have been doing yard jobs. The driver, Hans Giga w/m 37 was found to have been drinking. After failing SFST's he was arrested and brought to KPD Jail where he refused the datamaster by providing an invalid sample on two separate attempts. Lance P Cole, wm, 24; was then placed under arrest for Harassing a Police Dog. Bobbie E Pierce, wf, 22; was arrested for DC/PI. Both subjects were taken to KPD Jail for booking. 09-18498

The male subject was loud and continued to cause disruption during the investigation. Daniel J Angelone, wm, 23; was arrested for DC. The female half was taken to KMC for treatment. Inside the apartment was a 13 yr old male and 10 year old female. The male had spinal bifida, was sick, and had soiled himself.(After medics left) Children's services was called to the scene as well as a second medic. The 13 year old was transported to MVH. Separate reports for Endangering Children were written for prosecutorial review. 09-18653

0115 Ptl Geckler and Sgt Gangwer were dispatched to Capri Lanes on a juvenile disturbance. Upon arrival, over 100 youths were found being loud and disorderly both inside and outside the business. The business was closed and everyone forced off the premises. While removing the individuals, an altercation between a bm and bf was witnessed in the median of S Dixie, in front of Capri. The bm was seen spitting on the bf. Attempting to get away from him, the female ran to the Capri lot. The male subject followed, continually cursing at her. It appeared he was about to assault her. Sgt Gangwer intercepted the individual and put him down on the ground. He was handcuffed and arrested for DC. Search incident to arrest revealed two baggies containing suspected cocaine and over \$200 in small bills. Kisun J Taylor, bm, 34; was also charged with Drug Possession.
