POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, April 20, 2009

1517 Ptl. Gaudette was sent to the Rite Aid on E. Stoop Rd. to investigate a Trespassing complaint. The suspect was found walking down Stoop and after a positive ID from the store manager, Dalejandro Groves b/m 39, was charged with trespassing and given a court date. 09-18884

A stop was made and the driver was found to have been drinking. After failing SFST's, Patrick C.
