POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, April 27, 2010

2152 An officer stopped a vehicle on Research Blvd. for a traffic violation. The driver was contacted and found to be wanted on an FTA warrant through Fairborn. The warrant was confirmed and Candace O'Kelly, w/f/21, was placed under arrest and transported to KPD jail. 10-19344

Tuesday, April 28, 2010

0213 An officer was on patrol in the area of Bigger Rd. and Rahn Rd. when he observed a vehicle traveling southbound in front of him. The vehicle appeared to be weaving and then changed lanes without signaling. A traffic stop was initiated and upon contact with the operator he could smell alcohol. ROBERT D.
