POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, May 3, 2010

1810 Officers responded to the CVS on E. Dorothy for a possible family problem. At the scene, officers found the male half seated in the driver's seat of a car in the parking lot with the keys in the ignition. Officers determined the family problem to be minor but found the male been drinking and subsequently failed several field sobriety tests.
