POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, May 24, 2010

1645 An officer was dispatched to the MCSO jail on a warrant detail. Upon arrival, he took custody of Ryan A. Powell, w/m/29, on an active Kettering Felony Theft warrant. He was transported to KPD jail without incident. 10-20474
