POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, June 21, 2010

1838 An officer was dispatched to 3009 Woodman on a lock out. After unlocking the vehicle, a routine warrant check revealed that the driver had an active warrant out for her arrest. Arrested was Rhonda C. Callahan W/F/45 for a misdemeanor warrant through Franklin PD. 10-29242

2042 An officer stopped a vehicle in the area of Wilmington and Stroop for a traffic violation. Upon contacting the driver, he initially lied about his identity to avoid a citation for DUS. Arrested was Seth B. Engle W/M/20 for False Information to Avoid a Citation. 10-29265

An entry team was formed and entry was eventually made into the apartment to check for victims. The apartment was empty but at least two bullet holes were found in the walls. The residents of the apartment returned and were interviewed by detectives who were already on scene. There was some sort of disagreement between the male & female resident, a black male, and a second black male. There are some inconsistencies in the stories and the detectives are sorting it out. 10-29880

1740 Officers were dispatched to the area of Waterbury and W. Stroop for 3 suspicious males. The officers located the subjects and upon checking them for warrants, learned that one was wanted on three Dayton warrants. Once the warrants were confirmed, JAMES MASSEY II, W/M/42, was placed under arrest and transported to KPD jail. 10-29883
