POLICE BLOTTER

Thursday, July 1, 2010

0119 Officers were sent to 532 Telford Av. Apt. B on the report of a girlfriend/boyfriend problem. Investigation revealed there was an active TPO and active warrant against the boyfriend. Dana V. Lindsey, b/m/35, was arrested on both and transported to the KPD jail. (10-30802)

0212 Officers were sent to 160 Cannonbury Ct. Apt. U on the report of a disturbance involving an intoxicated boyfriend and girlfriend. The boyfriend was determined to be too intoxicated to care for himself and ignored the officers commands to quit yelling. Steven R.
