## **POLICE BLOTTER**

Monday, June 29, 2009

0850 Ptl. Mannix was dispatched to Meijers on a theft. On arrival he spoke with store security and found that Karen Rowe had left the store without paying for items. The defendant was arrested for theft and a warrant from Moraine PD. She was transported to KPD jail.

0919 Ptl. S Geisel was dispatched to 3117 Delaney to assist KFD on a non-breather. Upon arrival, he found the victim Geraldine Perry age 80; on the ground between the house and garage deceased. The Mont. County Coroner's Office Investigator Tom Lawson responded to the scene. The body was removed to their office. The death appears to be natural causes.
