POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, July 12, 2010

1728 An officer responded to Whipp and Marshall Rd. on a warrant service. There she met with a CPD unit who had a subject under arrest on our warrant. Arrested was Jay W. Martin W/M/28 for 3 theft warrants. 10-25987

2125 An officer stopped a car at Dorothy and Valleywood for a traffic violation. The driver was contacted and found to be intoxicated. After failing several field sobriety tests, James E. Hogan, w/m/48, was placed under arrest for OVI and transported to KPD jail. 10-32784

2200 Officers were dispatched to 3038 Grace Av. on the report of a family trouble. The male half was contacted by both officers, he was intoxicated and passed out on his bed.
