July 9, 2009

1535 Off. K. McGuire and A. Pedro were dispatched to 4429 Wilmington Pk., Apt. B on a warrant service. They contacted the manager and confirmed that the defendant was still a resident in the complex. They went with the manager to the defendant's apartment and attempted contact. Eventually the defendant responded and after her ID was confirmed they advised her that she was under arrest. The defendant was in a robe and asked to get dressed, the two officers entered the apartment and Off. Pedro accompanied the defendant to her bedroom as she got dressed. Off. McGuire stood outside the bedroom door and he observed what appeared to be crack cocaine lying on the dinning room table. The defendant was the only person in the apartment at that time. THERESA M.
