POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, July 19, 2010

1702 An officer responded to the Kettering Jail on a warrant service. Upon arrival, he served Marcia D. Shields with an active Kettering FTC warrant. 10-17762

1745 An officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation in the 2400 Block of S. Dixie. Upon contacting the two occupants, it was learned the driver had no O.L. and the passenger was wanted on an active Attempt Burglary warrant from Huber Heights. During a subsequent search of the vehicle, a loaded .357 Magnum was located behind the passenger seat covered by a jacket. A small amount of Marijuana was also found in the car after K-9 Brix alerted on the vehicle. As a result, Samuel Spiva, b/m/18, was placed under arrest for the warrant, CCW, and Receiving Stolen Property. He was also issued a summons for possession of Marijuana.
