POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, August 16, 2010

1520 An officer responded to Kroger on E. Dorothy for a shoplifter in custody. After a preliminary investigation, Gladys I. Gives, w/f/50, was placed under arrest for theft and transported to KPD jail. 10-38743
