POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, August 23, 2010

1800 An officer responded to the MCSO jail on a warrant detail. Upon arrival, Mark A. Hymer, w/m/25, was taken into custody on an active Kettering warrant and transported to KPD jail. 10-12315

2347 Several officers were sent to the Diplomat Lounge on the report of a disturbance involving subjects fighting inside and outside the establishment. The person who was the main problem fled on foot. This subject was located a short time later in the area of 1201 Colfax Av. and found to be highly intoxicated and unable to care for himself.
