Monday, August 31, 2009

Tuesday, September 1, 2009

2322 Officers Sanders, Geckler, and M. Woolf were sent to the area of 2616 Vale Dr. on the report of a hit and run crash involving a pick-up truck hitting a parked car. Off. Geckler followed tire marks from the scene and located the truck parked and unoccupied in front of 2804 Fields Av. Witnesses then reported seeing a male running from the truck and provided a description. Off. Woolf located the male walking south on Prentice St. and stopped him. The male was found to be the owner of the truck. He denied driving and said his truck had been stolen but did not want to file a theft report. He was later positively identified as the subject the two witnesses saw run from the truck. Based on the evidence and witness statements, Tommy Lee David Owens, w/m/22, was arrested for OVI and Hit and Run and transported to the KPD Jail. When at the jail, Owens agreed to perform SFST's and also agreed to the requested breath test. He tested 0.156% on the Datamaster and also decided to recant his original story about his truck being stolen. He admitted he had been driving to an address on Sousa Pl. to get a sober friend to drive him the rest of the way home. He was issued several citations along with a misdemeanor summons for an open container of an alcoholic beverage discovered in his truck. (09-42418)

Wednesday, September 2, 2009

0535 Officers were sent to the area of Wilmington and Stroop on the report of a single vehicle crash into a utility pole. The investigation revealed the driver failed to control his vehicle while southbound on Wilmington Pike and left the eastside of the roadway. The vehicle struck a wooden utility pole (causing numerous wires to hang low across Wilmington Pike) and then continued south and striking a metal street light pole. The accident caused Wilmington Pike to be closed in both directions for several hours so the utility companies could make repairs. The roadway was reopened by 0800 hrs.

1130 Ptl Bodner and several other officers were dispatched to the Medicine Shoppe at 3600 Wilmington Pike for a Robbery. It appears that a w/m entered the store, approached the counter and displayed a hand gun. The suspect demanded VICODIN which he obtained and then fled the store. The suspect possibly left on a motorcycle southbound on Wilmington. The suspect is described as a W/M 5'10". He was wearing a multi-colored helmet (black, blue and white) a dark sweatshirt, blue jeans, gloves and sunglasses. The incident remains under investigation.
