**Tuesday, October 20, 2009**

0830 Several officers and medic crews were dispatched to Shroyer Rd. at Lincoln Pk. on a report of an injury accident. Upon arrival, officers found two female victims trapped in their vehicle. It appears that medical issue may have caused the vehicle operator to lose control and leave the roadway, striking a utility pole. KFD and the street dept responded to the scene and assisted. AIT's were called out and the investigation continues.

1515 Officers were sent to 2750 Bobbie Place on a disturbance. Upon their arrival, they learned that Michael A. Hartley, w/m 21, had threatened to come to the address and assault the resident.
