Monday, October 26, 2009

1745 Ptl. Lambert was sent to the Kroger at 2115 E. Dorothy Lane on a report of a theft offense. Upon arrival, he met with store security and learned that an Amanda J. Roberts w/f 22 and Donald R. Kelly w/m 26 had been caught stealing \$45.31 worth of groceries. Both were arrested and brought to KPD Jail without incident.

Tuesday, October 27, 2009

0030 Officer W. Aldrich was dispatched to the Green County Jail to pick-up Robert B. Lairmore (W/M/54), who was wanted on our FTC warrant with the original charge being Theft. He was brought to KPD Jail without incident.
