POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, December 14, 2009

1530 Lt. Karolyi, Ptl. McGuire and Miller went to 4421 Wilmington Pike #C on a warrant service. The resident provided a key for the door and explained that her ex boyfriend, Christopher Roberts w/m 18 was inside. Checking leads, Roberts was found to be wanted for Assault and Menacing through KPD. Ptl. McGuire unlocked the bottom lock with the key and opened the door. After the door opened 2-3 inches, it was slammed in his face and the deadbolt was thrown. Ptl. McGuire was able to open the door. Roberts was seen attempting to flee to the back bedroom and was taken into custody.

1645 Ptl. Miller and Price were sent to the Ride-Aid on E. Stroop on the report of an intoxicated female in the store. Upon arrival, they located Terri Hall w/f 26 walking down Stroop Road. Running a leads check on Hall, she was found to be wanted on a warrant through MCSO.
