Kettering- Jesse B. Weaver Jr., age 41 of Trotwood, was arrested by Kettering Police on February 2 on charges of Deception to Obtain A Dangerous Drug, Possession of Drugs, and Illegal Processing of Drug Documents.

Patrol officers responded to Kettering Memorial Hospital when Weaver had passed fraudulent prescriptions. Through the course of the investigation it was learned that the prescriptions forms were illegally obtained, forged and presented.

Weaver was found in possession of 400 pills including Oxycontin, Percocet and Xanax and booked into the Kettering jail. The Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office approved two Felony counts of Deception to Obtain a Dangerous Drug.
