



## **KETTERING SAFETY VILLAGE 2009**

### **A children's life safety awareness mini-camp**

The members of the **Dor-Wood Optimist Club** founded and continue to sponsor the **Kettering Safety Village**. The **City of Kettering's Engineering Department Safety Section** is proud to operate the mini-camp along with the Kettering City School system. The Village is established to provide you and your child with basic traffic safety and life safety education. Safety Village consists of scaled down streets, buildings and intersections constructed at one of the City of Kettering's elementary schools. The village includes traffic and pedestrian signals, street signs, and pavement markings in a secured outdoor site near the school building. The children practice crossing the street and driving Kettcars in a changing physical and social environment. Safety professionals believe practicing safety skills are important in helping your child understand and feel comfortable with the experiences of traveling to and from school. The program is for children of ages 5 to 6 years old.

#### **CHILDREN'S CLASS**

Through **fun and exciting "edutainment" experiences** children will learn about traffic signs and signals, seat belt safety, safety patrols, school bus safety, animal safety, personal safety, fire safety, water safety and poison safety. The City's Safety Supervisors, Police and Fire personnel teach the class lessons and are assisted by local student volunteers.

#### **PARENT/GRANDPARENT CLASS**

Adults will learn of other community safety resources and activities through presentations by City Safety Supervisor, Police and Fire staff. Adults will gain valuable life safety and emergency preparedness concepts to further help their family. The Parent's Class is conducted Tuesday through Thursday during the same time as their child's class. Parents or grandparents participating in the Parent's Class have an added benefit to use the **on-site childcare** for younger siblings at no further cost.

Class registration will be closed **seven** days prior to the listed weekly Session start date.
