A children's life safety awareness mini-camp

The members of the **Dor-Wood Optimist Club** founded the Kettering Safety Village in 1966 and continue with their outstanding sponsorship.

The **City of Kettering's Engineering Department Safety Section** is proud to operate the mini-camp along with the Kettering City School system. The Village is established to provide you and your child with basic traffic safety and life safety education. Safety Village consists of scaled down streets, buildings and intersections constructed at one of the City of Kettering elementary schools. The Village includes traffic and pedestrian signals, street signs, and pavement markings in a secured outdoor site near the school building. The children practice crossing the street and driving Kettcars in a changing physical and social environment. Safety professionals believe practicing safety skills is important in helping children understand and feel comfortable with the experiences of traveling to and from school. The program is for children ages 5 to 6 years old.

CHILDREN'S CLASS

Through **fun and exciting "edutainment" experiences**, children will learn about traffic signs and signals, seat belt safety, safety patrols, school bus safety, animal safety, personal safety, fire safety, water safety and poison safety. The City's Safety Supervisors, Police and Fire personnel teach the class lessons and are assisted by local student volunteers.

Residents and Non-residents can begin enrolling in Safety Village online on Monday, April 5 at 8 a.m. Terminals are available at the Kettering Recreation Complex and Rosewood Arts Centre if patrons do not have a computer. Also, patrons who do not have a credit card may pay in advance by check at the Kettering Recreation Complex or Rosewood Arts Centre to have a balance placed in their household account to use online.
