to do. You will complete 4 or 5 cards and learn techniques to make many more. Supplies included in fee

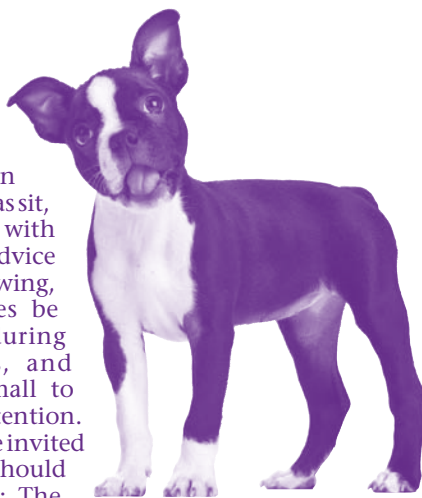
