Yard Debris Drop-off Center

LOCATION: On Woodman Center Drive off Dorothy Lane.

HOURS: Monday through Friday — 3 - 8 p.m.
Saturday — 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

CLOSED: Sundays, holidays and during hazardous weather.

WINTER HOURS: Mid-December through Mid-March

What We Accept

BRUSH & LIMBS:

Please cut in length of 4 feet or shorter and bundle with string or jute, or place load on tarp and draw up the corners. Limb thickness must be 4 inches in diameter or less. Items longer than 4 feet and limbs thicker than 4 inches in diameter will be refused.

SMALLER TRIMMINGS:

Smaller trimmings may be placed in trash cans or on tarps. Items in paper and plastic bags will not be accepted.

What We Cannot Accept

Grass clippings, thatch, sod, dirt, rocks, concrete or building and construction materials. These items contaminate the composting process and cause equipment failure.

What Happens to Your Yard Debris

The Yard Debris is compacted and transported to our composting site. Then it is reduced by a "tub grinder" and laid in rows to decompose. The rows are turned regularly and microorganisms are added to speed up the decomposition. The end product is rich organic soil and mulch used in the landscaping and planting process.

Yard Debris Pick-Up

You may call your refuse hauler to purchase special yard debris bags to be set out with your regular refuse. The cost of these bags are to cover the surcharge for disposing of yard debris. As an additional convenience, the City of Kettering offers these bags for sale in whole dollar amounts. They are not for sale by the City at any other time or location.
